

**ADDENDUM TO THE TRANSFER AGREEMENT  
SIGNED ON SEPTEMBER 28, 2015  
BETWEEN  
THE BOARD OF MANAGEMENT  
AND  
NEW BRUNSWICK UNION OF PUBLIC AND PRIVATE EMPLOYEES  
RE: CLINICAL ENGINEERING TECHNOLOGISTS**

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Whereas the Medical Science Professional collective agreement entered into on September 24, 2015, provides for a pay increase effective the date of signing; and

Whereas the Transfer Agreement provides at clause 22 (Wages) that “Former FacilicorpNB employees transferring into one of the newly established SNB Clinical Engineering Technologist classifications will maintain his/her current rate of pay as of September 30, 2015”;

This addendum THEREFORE amends the wage scales set out in clause 22 of the Transfer Agreement as follows:


